Treasurer's Report: The opening bank balance for June was £2,209.93 with the cash in hand amounting to £307.75 making the total monies £2,517.68. The income for June was £584.50 which came from £500 from Harwood Golf club as payment towards the Lady Captain's Invitation Day, £77.50 for evening meals for LCID and £7.00 for purchase of a rule book.
